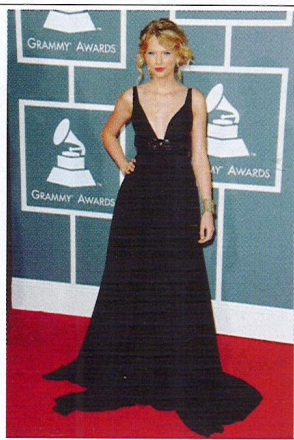
**WHITE LION**

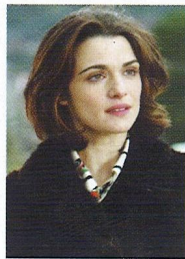
